

UNIFORM REGULATIONS

WINTER UNIFORM

(October Half Term – Easter)

- YEAR 7** Knee length, or below, pleated plaid skirt*
- YEARS 8 & 9** Pleated plaid skirt*, to be worn no more than 2" above the knee
- YEARS 10 & 11** Straight plaid skirt with rear pleat, to be worn no more than 2" above the knee
- OR**
- Pleated plaid skirt* to be worn no more than 2" above the knee

TWGGGS logo jumper

Plain white school reverse collar blouse, with TWGGGS logo

Opaque black or navy tights or white, black or navy ankle socks

Low-heeled formal black shoes. Trainer style, canvas shoes, Converse, Kickers and Vans are not permitted

Scarves (black, dark grey, navy or plaid). Must not be worn in school

Sheer flesh coloured tights and leggings are not permitted

Optional **YEARS 7-11**

School uniform trousers – must be navy with the school logo, purchased from Simmonds

SUMMER UNIFORM *(Easter – October Half Term)*

The full winter uniform (including trousers) may be worn all year round.

OR

- YEAR 7** Plaid summer dress* - knee length, or below
- YEARS 8 & 9** Plaid summer dress* - to be worn no more than 2" above the knee
- YEARS 10 & 11** Plaid summer dress* - to be worn no more than 2" above the knee

Opaque black or navy tights or white, black or navy ankle socks

Low-heeled formal black shoes. Trainer style, canvas shoes, Converse, Kickers and Vans are not permitted

Sheer flesh coloured tights and leggings are not permitted

* Skirt/Dress must be worn as supplied without alterations to style and the skirt must not be worn rolled up

Muslim pupils who wish to wear hijabs may do so provided that the fabric is plain, lightweight and dark blue or black. In the interests of Health and Safety, headscarves and hair must be tied back securely in all practical activities. Garments covering the face or whole body are not permitted.

When an outdoor coat is necessary, it must be plain black, navy or grey. Denim, leather or plastic coats may not be worn. Coats should not be worn around the school. Full uniform must be worn to and from school as well as in school.

Uniform must be kept in good repair, and look presentable at all times.

OTHER ITEMS

No jewellery allowed, other than that stated below

| Hair clips, slides, scrunchy | navy/brown/black – all to be of a plain style |
| Necklace | none, except small religious symbol on a plain, thin gold/silver chain |
| Piercings | one small earring may be worn in the lobe of each ear. This must be of gold or silver colour and may be either a small stud or an earring that lies against the lobe; no additional earrings or piercings are allowed |
| Badges | Form Captain, Duke of Edinburgh, Arts Award |
| Make-up | If make-up is worn, it should be minimal/not noticeable. Nail varnish is not permitted. No extreme hairstyles or colours |
