TWGGGS has exciting plans to build on the school's academic excellence by opening a brand new multi-purpose sports hall in 2020.

This will enable pupils of all abilities to:

- **Gain the self-confidence, drive, resilience, teamwork abilities and leadership skills to aim high and thrive throughout their lives**
- **Develop new abilities, realise ambitions and unlock potential**
- **Participate all year round in high quality sports education and achieve competitive success at school, county and national levels**
- **Discover new sporting, gym, dance and extra-curricular activities such as basketball, badminton or short tennis**
- **Develop a passion for exercise, be energised to learn and establish healthy exercise habits for lifelong physical and mental wellbeing**

The impressive new indoor courts, gymnastics area, mirrored dance studio and changing rooms will replace dated, overstretched facilities which are not fit for purpose, and the flexible space will provide additional capacity for wider school activity.

Planning permission has been confirmed but TWGGGS cannot access Government funding for this build. We are immensely grateful to those who have already donated, however **we urgently need more support to enable construction to commence this year.**

Just as previous generations of TWGGGS parents have donated to provide facilities that your daughters now benefit from, your generosity to this appeal will help to inspire current and future generations of pupils into sport.
